

How to double an 8 inch square cake?

The volume of a 9x13 baking pan is just under double that of an 8x8 square baking pan (9"x13"=117 square inches; 8"x8"x2=128 square inches). So, doubling the ingredients is acceptable (but perhaps using less leavener). However, you will need to lengthen the baking time.

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
